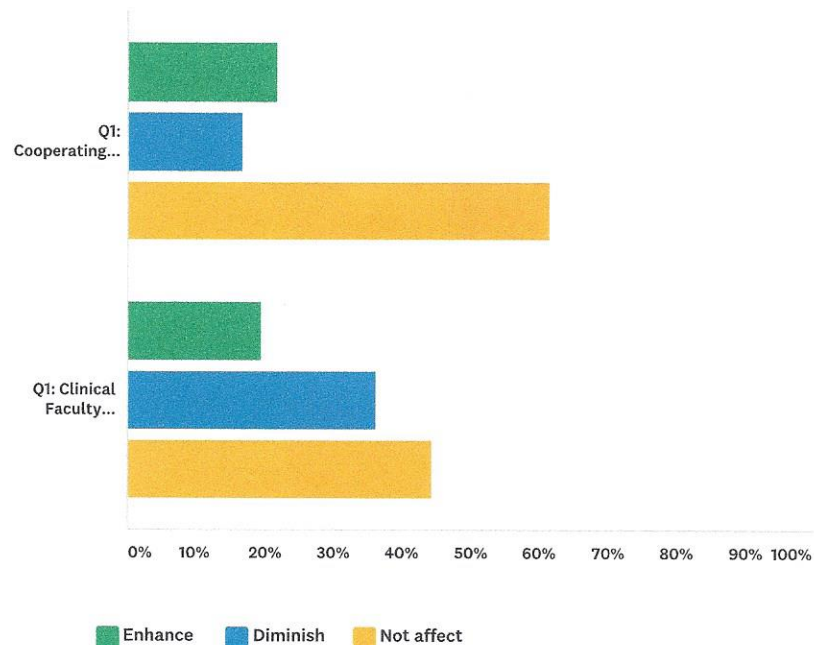

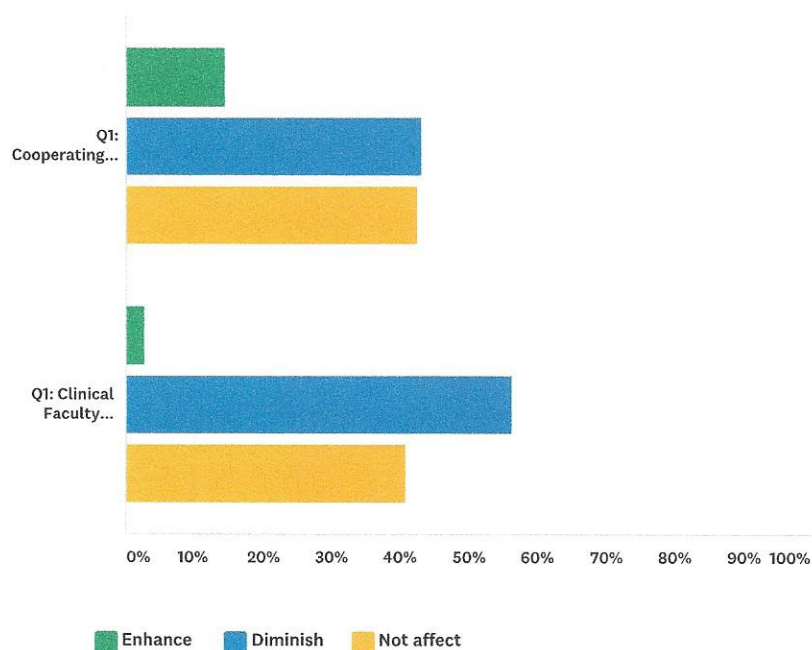

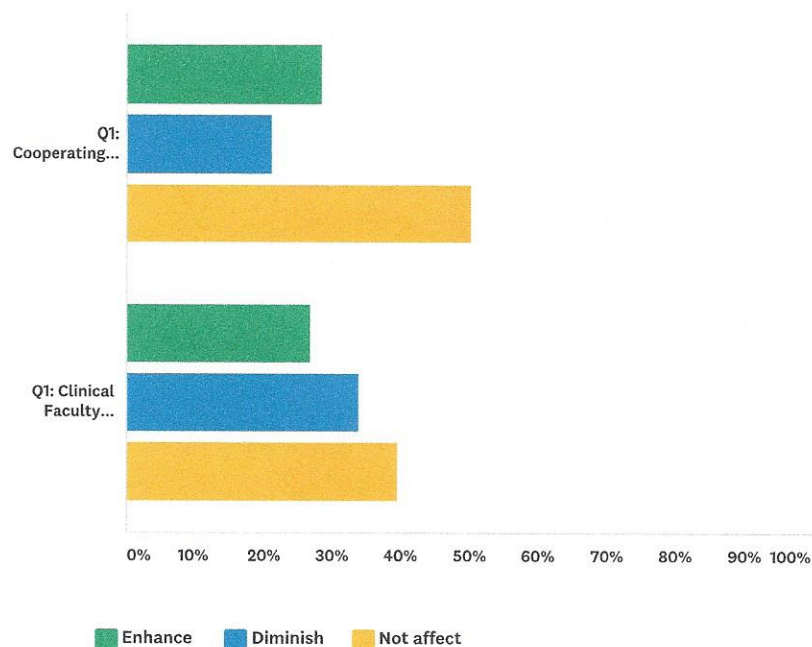

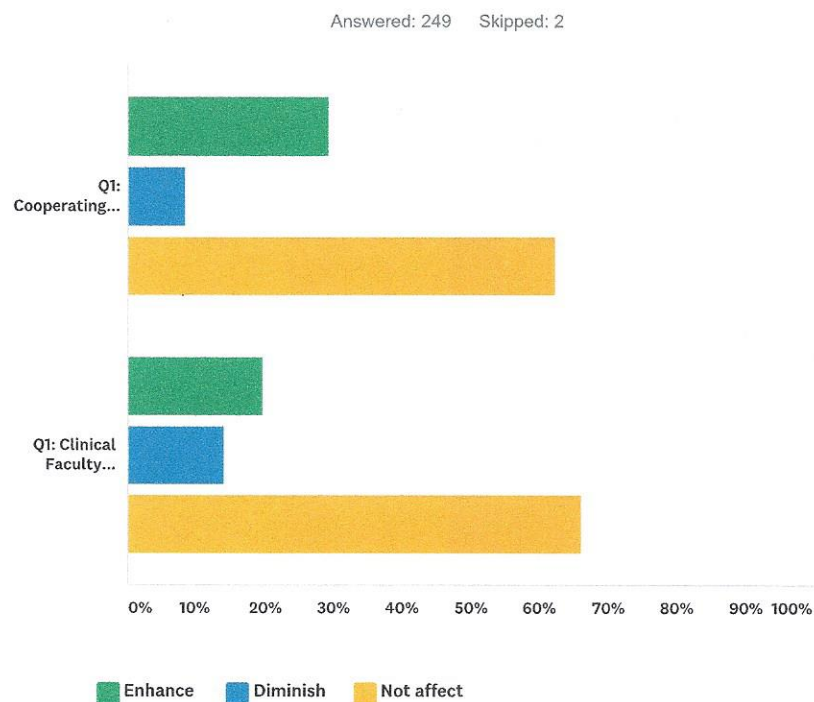
## Q8 In your opinion, does the edTPA enhance, diminish, or not affect student teachers' focus on getting to know their students and their learning preferences and needs?

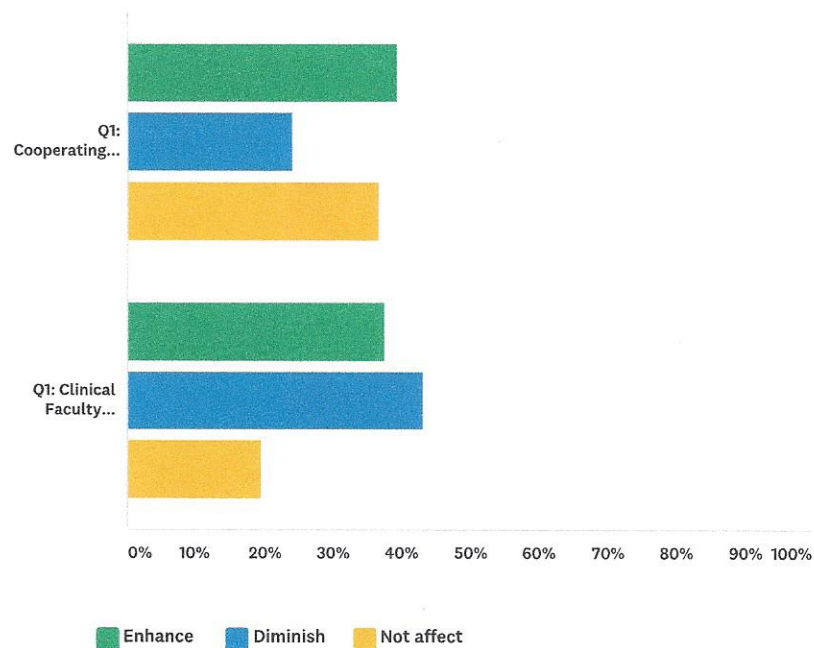

### Q10 In your opinion, does the edTPA enhance, diminish, or not affect student teachers' preparation of lessons and supporting materials?

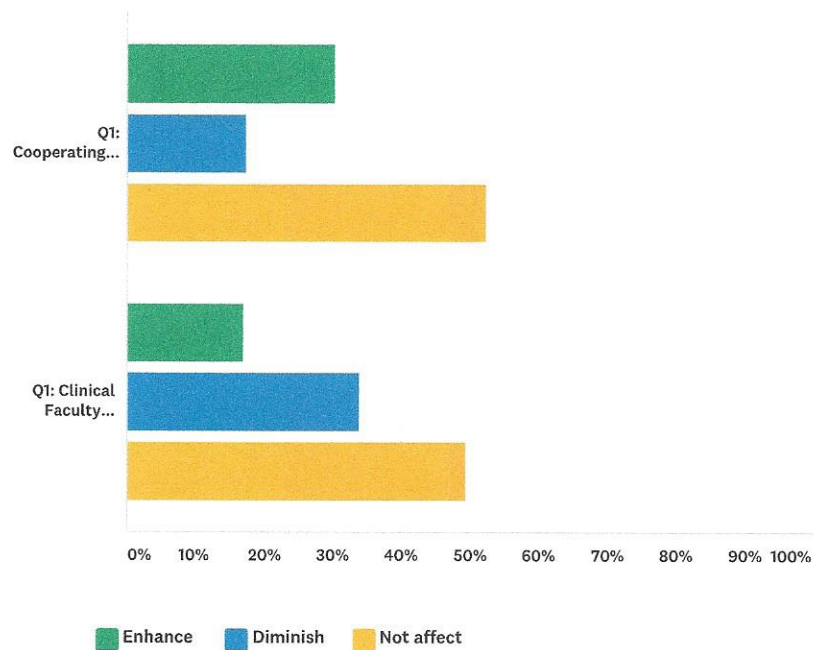

### Q11 In your opinion, does the edTPA enhance, diminish, or not affect student teachers' collaboration with you, your colleagues, special education staff or others?

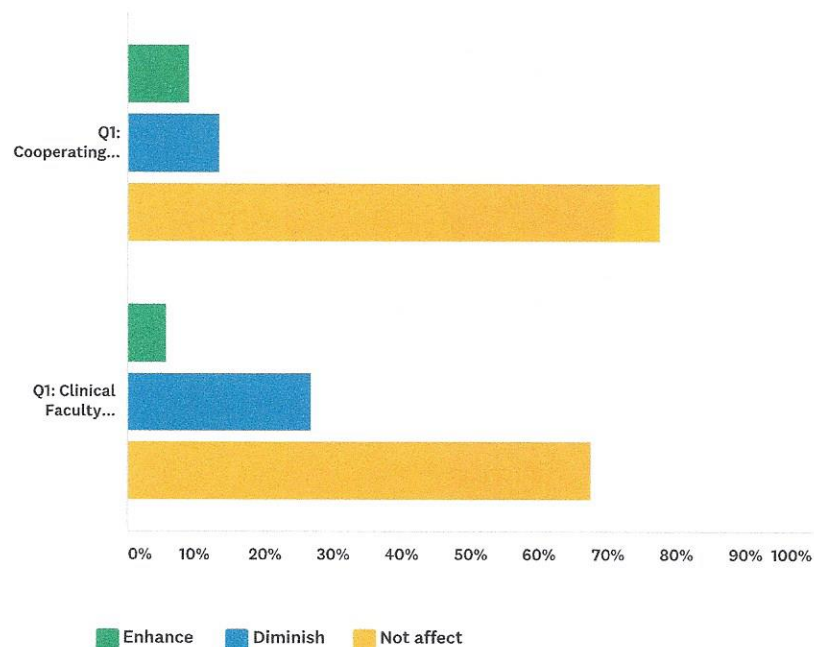

## Q12 In your opinion, does the edTPA enhance, diminish, or not affect student teachers' contact with parents about their child's academic performance or class behavior?

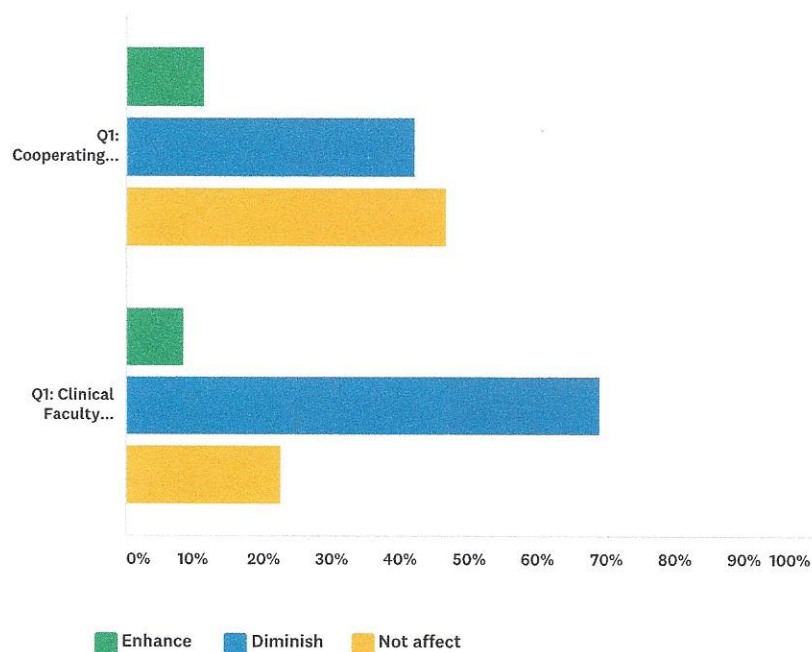

### Q13 In your opinion, does the edTPA enhance, diminish, or not affect student teachers' enthusiasm for their students and the teaching profession?

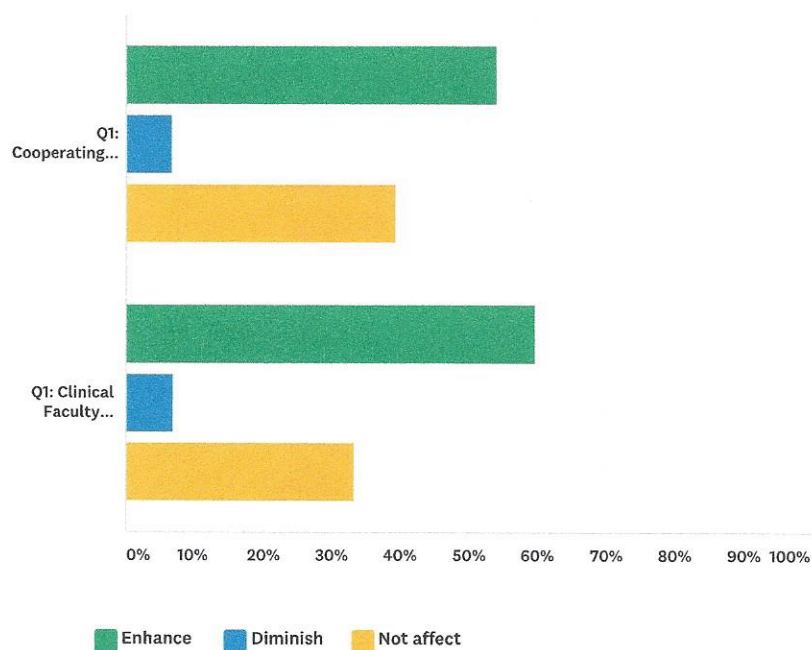

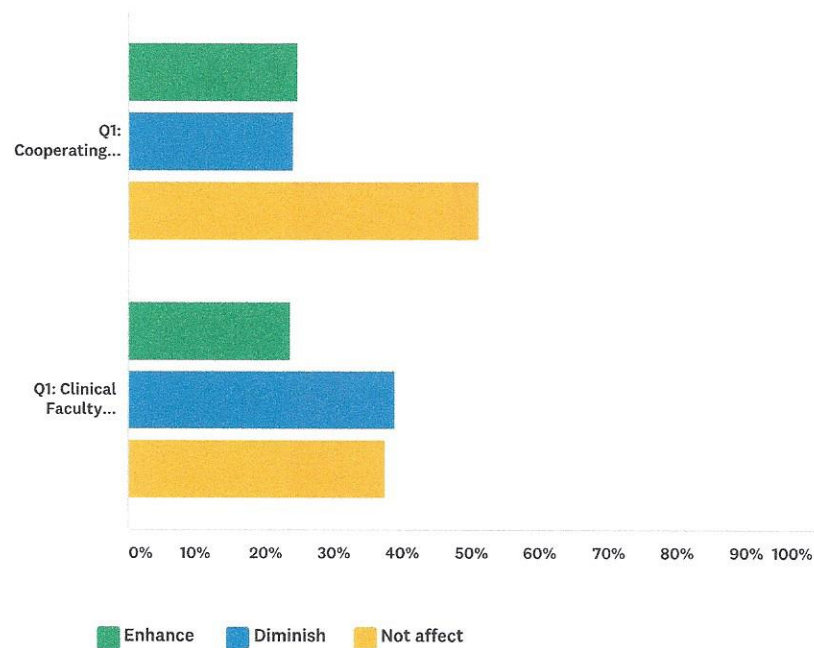

# Q15 In your opinion, does the edTPA enhance, diminish, or not affect student teachers' classroom "readiness"?

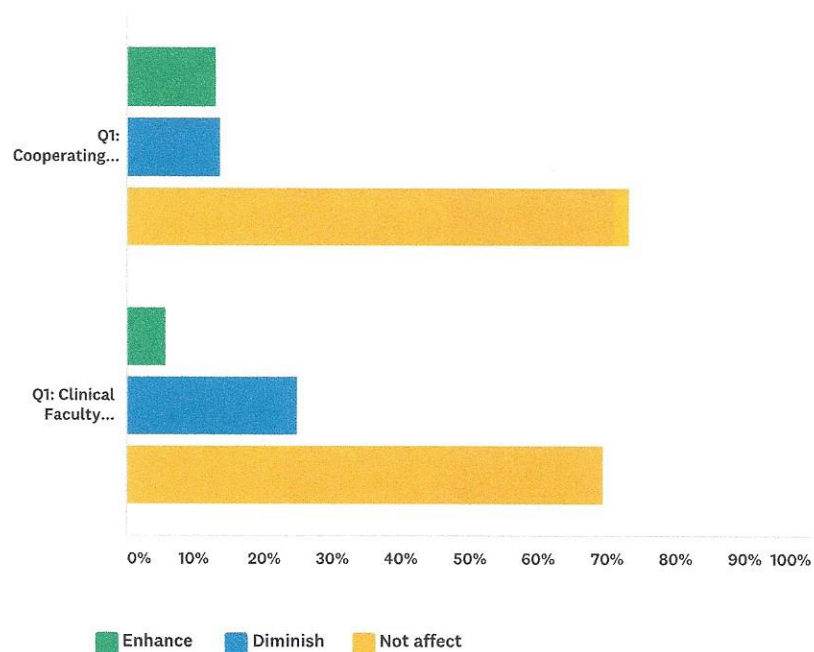

### Q16 In your opinion, does the edTPA enhance, diminish, or not affect attendance of student teachers.

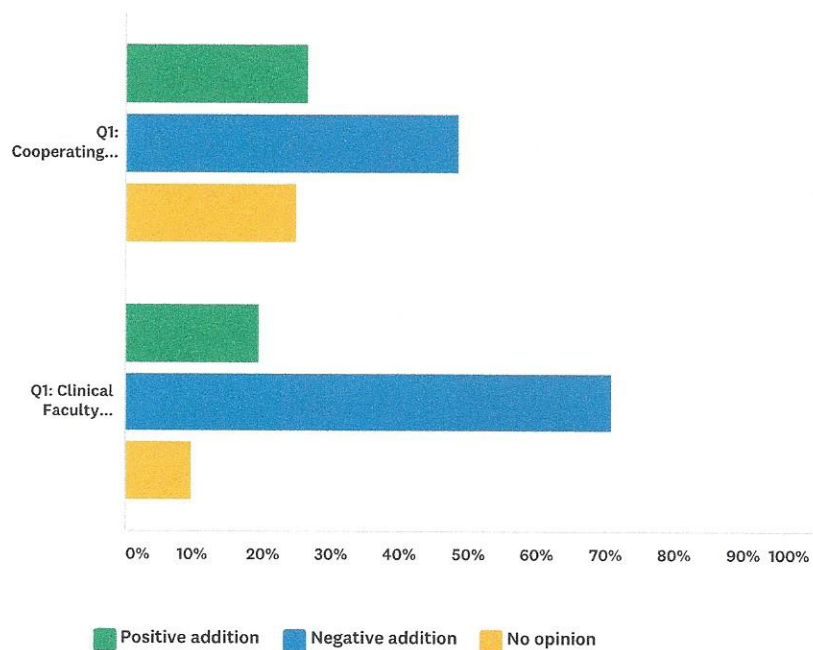
