Illinois School District Superintendent edTPA Survey  
Summary of Results**

282 responses = approximately 33% return  
2/22/2017 – 3/8/2017

**District schools:**

- Elementary schools 247 (88%)
  - Middle schools 207 (73%)
  - High schools 179 (63%)
- 282 responses\*

**District setting:**

- Rural 191 (68%)
  - Suburban 87 (31%)
  - Urban 10 (4%)
- 282 responses\*

**Familiarity with edTPA:**

- Somewhat familiar 166 (59%)
  - Very familiar 56 (20%)
  - Not familiar at all 52 (19%)
  - Not aware 6 (2%)
- 280 responses

**School district policy on student teaching with advent of edTPA requirement:**

- No change 141 (50%)
  - No policy 98 (35%)
  - Stopped hosting 11 (4%)
  - Up to each school 5 (2%)
  - Other 27 (10%)
- 282 responses

**Major concerns about the edTPA leading to decision not to host student teachers:**

- Privacy 32 (36%)
  - Accountability 29 (33%)
  - Predictive validity 28 (32%)
  - Impact on student teaching 25 (28%)
  - Diversity 15 (17%)
  - Other (see attached) 46 (52%)
- 88 responses\*

Schools in at least 88 districts have not hosted student teachers because of the edTPA.

**Positive or negative addition to student teaching:**

- Only 31 (11%) of the superintendents view edTPA as a positive addition to student teaching
  - No opinion 126 (45%)
  - Negative addition 121 (44%)
  - Positive addition 31 (11%)
- 276 responses
